****DNHAS** stands for the Dorset Natural History and Archaeological Society, and is the name of the charity which operates as the Dorset County Museum.

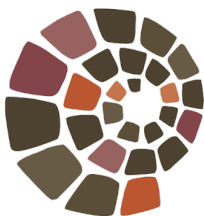
5. Give more at no extra cost to you *giftaid it*
